

Eō- Present

1. nvi. To answer, reply yes, agree, say, talk; halloo, yes (in reply); tinkling, tolling, or chime of a bell; resonance, as generated by the thumping of a gourd drum on a pad; sound of whistling (Kaua'i); sound of peacocks; to make such sounds. Kou inoa, e ō mai (FS 199), your name chant, answer. E uhaele kākou i kahakai. Ō, e uhaele 'i'o aku kākou. Let's go to the beach. Yes, let's do go. (PPN oo.)

'Ae- Support

1. vt. interj. Yes; to say yes, consent, conform, grant, agree, approve, let, confirm, admit, permit, allow, accept, yield; approval, admission, permission. Cf. *a'e nei*. 'Ae waha, oral agreement. 'Ae wale, to agree easily; pliable. Ua 'ae mai 'oia i ko'u hele, he consented to my going. (PCP (')a(a)e.)

'A'ole- Do not support

interj. No, not, never; to be none, to have none, -un. Commonly pronounced 'a'ale (Gram. 2.7). Cf. *'a'ohē*. 'A 'ole loa! Certainly not! Not at all! I should say not! Never! 'A'ole loa anei 'oe i hele i Hilo? Have you ever been to Hilo? 'A'ole paha, probably not, perhaps not (polite). 'A 'ole i ma'ama'ahia, unfamiliar. (PCP kakole.)

'Āpono-Approve

vi. To approve, confirm, justify, ratify, recommend, commend, consent, accept, endorse, adopt; to pass, as a bill. Cf. *pono*, proper, right. 'Āpono 'ole 'ia, disqualified, not approved or confirmed. ho'ā.pono To approve, accept, justify, find not guilty in a trial; approved, worthy; approbation, sanction, approval. Palapala ho'āpono, credentials, letter of recommendation.

Hō'ole-Not Approve

vt. To deny, repudiate. See *'ole*.

Kānalua-Abstain

nvi. Doubtful, undecided, dubious, uncertain; to doubt, hesitate, distrust; reluctance, doubt, hesitation. Members of the Territorial legislature abstained from voting by saying, "kānalua.rd; ho'o.kā.nalua To cause doubt. Ho'okānalu 'ole 'ia 'o kona 'doia'i'o, there is no cause to doubt its truth.
