

2018 Pacific States Biennial North American (PSBN) Juried Printmaking Exhibition

Established by the University of Hawaii at Hilo Art Department Print Studio as a regional biennial in 1982, the PSBN is currently supported through an international juried call for entry that is available to all artists 18 years or older presently residing in North America and the US Territories.

The current international showcase will feature 76 unique works, created using a full range of contemporary approaches to print media, and curated through a selection of 582 submissions representing artists from 28 states, and Canada. Portions of the exhibition will be presented in two separate venues that include the *University of Hawaii at Hilo Campus Center Gallery*, and the *East Hawaii Cultural Center* exhibition galleries, located at 141 Kalakaua Street, in downtown Hilo.

The 2018 PSBN was juried by **Helen Frederick**: artist, curator, international projects coordinator, and founder of Pyramid Atlantic. Early this year, Frederick was bestowed for a lifetime of educator achievement, the College Art Association (CAA) *Distinguished Teaching of Art Award*.
