APPLICATIONS: Unless applicant is a current UH Hilo student, applicant must submit a [UH Hilo Application for Admission](#) before submitting this Supplemental BSN Admission Application. Only official transcripts submitted to the UH Hilo Admissions Office will be used for nursing admission decisions.

COMPLETION OF PREREQUISITE COURSES: All prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better prior to starting the nursing program. Applicants should perform a self-assessment using the [BSN Basic Advising Checklist](#) and *attach a copy to this application*. **Note:** Only 16 credits of nursing prerequisite courses can be outstanding with a maximum of 8 credits in the required natural sciences by the end of the fall semester. Current Fall enrollment will not count towards the outstanding number of credits. Please note that grades will not be accepted for courses attempted more than twice. Only the most recent grade will be used for evaluation.

GPA: An overall GPA of 2.7 is required to be considered for admission. The overall GPA at UH Hilo will be used for evaluation. If the UHH GPA does not exist or is not 2.7 or greater, then the GPAs for the entire UH system will be averaged and applied. If the applicant is a transfer student into the UH System, official transcripts will be required to be sent to the School of Nursing prior to the November 1st deadline. The transfer GPA will be evaluated and applied. A natural science GPA of 3.0 is also required to be considered for admission. The natural science courses are BIOL 243/243L, 244/244L, 275/275L, CHEM 141, NURS 203, and NURS 348.

RETAKE POLICY: Only one retake of each natural science course will be allowed and the most recent grade will be used for evaluation. For all other courses, please follow the UH Hilo catalog. Students may not enroll in a course and receive a grade (including "W") more than three times, except in those courses identified in the Catalog as repeatable.

UH NURSING FACULTY ADVISING: Applicants should obtain academic counseling from a UH Hilo Nursing faculty adviser regarding their qualifications for admission within one semester prior to submitting the application. Please indicate the following:

NURSE ENTRANCE EXAM: The ATI (Assessment Technologies Institute) Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) is required. *A minimum score of 70% is required for admission.* Test scores must be attached to this application. Testing dates will be scheduled in August, September, and October.
