The amounts listed below in US dollars reflect the **average estimated cost** of attending the University of Hawaii at Hilo for the academic year 2023-24. **Your actual costs may vary depending on your living arrangements and spending habits.**

The required costs are the tuition and student fees that pay for campus facilities and activities. Tuition and fees for the academic year are fixed and are subject to change with University of Hawaii Board of Regents approval. Estimated personal expenses, transportation costs, medical insurance, books, and other school supplies are not fixed amounts, but they are included as estimates to help you plan for these expenses.
