SUBJECT: Three-Year Academic Calendar 2024-2027

After discussion and consultation with the appropriate system-wide groups, HGEA and UHPA, the academic calendar for all University of Hawai'i (UH) campuses for the period Fall 2024 through Summer 2027 is hereby approved. The calendar conforms to the Board of Regents' policy 5.205 and is in accordance with Article 5 of the UHPA Agreement 2021-2025. Note that the holiday observances for Good Friday and Kūhiō Day in 2027 are subject to change based on negotiation with applicable bargaining units.

All campuses are required to begin each semester on the same date and to observe the same holidays. As in the past, each campus establishes dates and deadlines for registration, advising, commencement and other academic activities. These dates are usually set prior to each semester and are published with registration materials.

Summer session dates listed are for the UH Mānoa Outreach College. Each campus schedules summer sessions according to the individual campus objectives.

UH reserves the right to modify the academic calendar as needed after appropriate review.

A credit hour is associated with an amount of work represented in intended learning outcomes and verified by evidence of student achievement. It reasonably approximates, but is not less than one hour of class or direct faculty instruction and a minimum of two hours of out of class student work each week for approximately 15 weeks for one semester or the equivalent amount of work over a different period of time OR at least an equivalent amount of work for other academic activities such as online instruction, laboratory work, internships, practica, studio work and other work that earns academic credit hour.

NOTES

1/ Official Faculty Duty Date: Reflects the official faculty duty dates for nine month faculty. "The beginning and ending dates for the duty period for each campus will be determined by the Employer, provided the beginning date shall be between August 14th and September 14th and run for nine (9) consecutive months thereafter." (Article V, UHPA-State of Hawai'i Agreement, 2021-2025)

2/ First Day of Instruction: All campuses of the UH System shall adhere to a common first day of instruction each semester and observe holidays established by law. (Board of Regents policy 5.205)

3/ Last Day of Instruction: Reflects the minimum number of instructional days or hour/minutes of instruction from the first day of instruction; may vary by campus.

4/ Study Period/Examination Period/Commencement: "Campuses may set internal dates for registration, study days, examinations, and commencement." (Board of Regents policy 5.205)

5/ Summer Session: "Each campus shall schedule summer sessions according to its individual campus mission." UH Mānoa summer session dates are included as a sample. (Board of Regents policy 5.205)

6/ Faculty Duty Date for Newly Hired Faculty: New faculty, meaning faculty with a start of employment scheduled for Spring Semester, have an official starting date. Continuing faculty, meaning those who are continuing their employment with UH, remain on-duty over the winter break. Continuing faculty need not be physically present on campus over break.

7/ Last Day of Term: Date that indicates the official end of the semester.
