This report summarizes data provided through the Consortium for Student Retention Data Exchange (CSRDE) and compares graduation and retention rates at the University of Hawai'i at Hilo with rates at its peer and benchmark institutions, and consortium institutions. It is coordinated by the Center for Institutional Data Exchange and Analysis (C-IDEA) at the College of Continuing Education, University of Oklahoma.

Consortium members provide graduation and retention rates, which entitles them to an annual report which can be used as a reference guide for benchmarking. Each consortium member is also entitled to individualized reports consisting of self-identified peers.

Using data from CSRDE, this report looks at three rates:

- **Retention/Continuation Rate:** The percentage of first-time freshmen in a given fall semester who returned to the institution in a subsequent fall semester.
- **Graduation Rate:** The cumulative percentage of first-time freshmen in a given fall semester who graduated within a designated period of time, measured as of the summer term.
- **Success Rate:** The percentage of first-time freshmen in a given fall semester who have either graduated or are still enrolled. The success rate is calculated by adding the graduation and continuation rates together.

Using these three rates, the University of Hawai'i at Hilo is compared with its benchmark and peer group institutions, and against 441 CSRDE member institutions who provided data for the 2007-2008 CSRDE report. It should be noted that there was no information for 5 out of 14 of Hilo's benchmark institutions (36%), and 6 out of 16 of its peer institutions (38%). Therefore, this report compares Hilo against 64% of its benchmark institutions and 62% of its peer institutions.

Appendix 1 shows which schools are included in Hilo's peer and benchmark groups, as well as graduation, retention, and success rate data for their Fall 2001 cohort.

Due to differing methodologies and databases, the data reported here differ from previously reported data from the NCHEMS/University of Hawai'i Longitudinal Database Project.

Graduation and Success Rates

Hilo's average six-year graduation rate is currently at 32%, 15 percentage points lower than the benchmark average of 47% and 3 percentage point lower than the peer group average of 35%.

Hilo's average six-year success rate is estimated at 39%. This is slightly lower than its peer group average of 41%, and 12 percentage points lower than its benchmark group rate of 51%. Hilo's six-year success rate is also 23 percentage points lower than the CSRDE success rate of 62%.

Caucasians and non-resident aliens have the highest average six-year graduation rates at Hilo (33%). Women have higher rates than men, 35% compared to 27%.

Retention Rates

Freshmen year is the most crucial period in student retention. At Hilo, an average of 61% of the starting cohort of students drop out within a six-year period: 40% in the first year, 15% in the second year, and slightly more than 6% in the third year or later. Of those dropping out, half drop out in their freshmen year. A similar pattern can be seen in data for peer, benchmark, and CSRDE groups.

Hilo's one-year retention rate is 63%, compared to 75% for the benchmark group and 68% for the peer group.

Women have a higher one-year retention rate than men, 65% compared with 60%. Asian and non-resident aliens have the highest first-year retention rates, 66% and 72% respectively.

Summary

- Hilo's average six-year graduation rate is 32%.
- Hilo's average six-year graduation rate is lower than its benchmark group, and slightly lower than its peer group. A similar pattern can be seen in six-year success rates.
- An average of 63% of Hilo's students return for their second year.
- The first year is the crucial period in student retention. Over half the dropouts do so in their freshmen year.
- Caucasians and non-resident aliens have the highest average six-year graduation rates. Asian and non-resident aliens have the highest average first-year retention rates.
- Women have higher graduation and retention rates than men.

1 year after entry

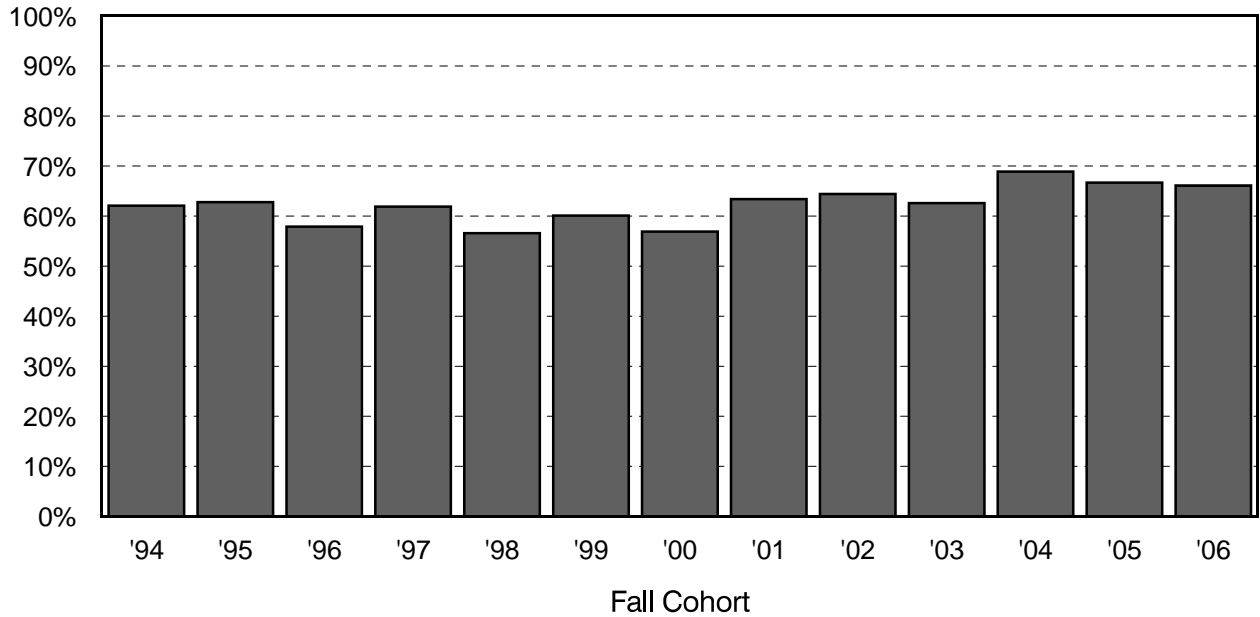
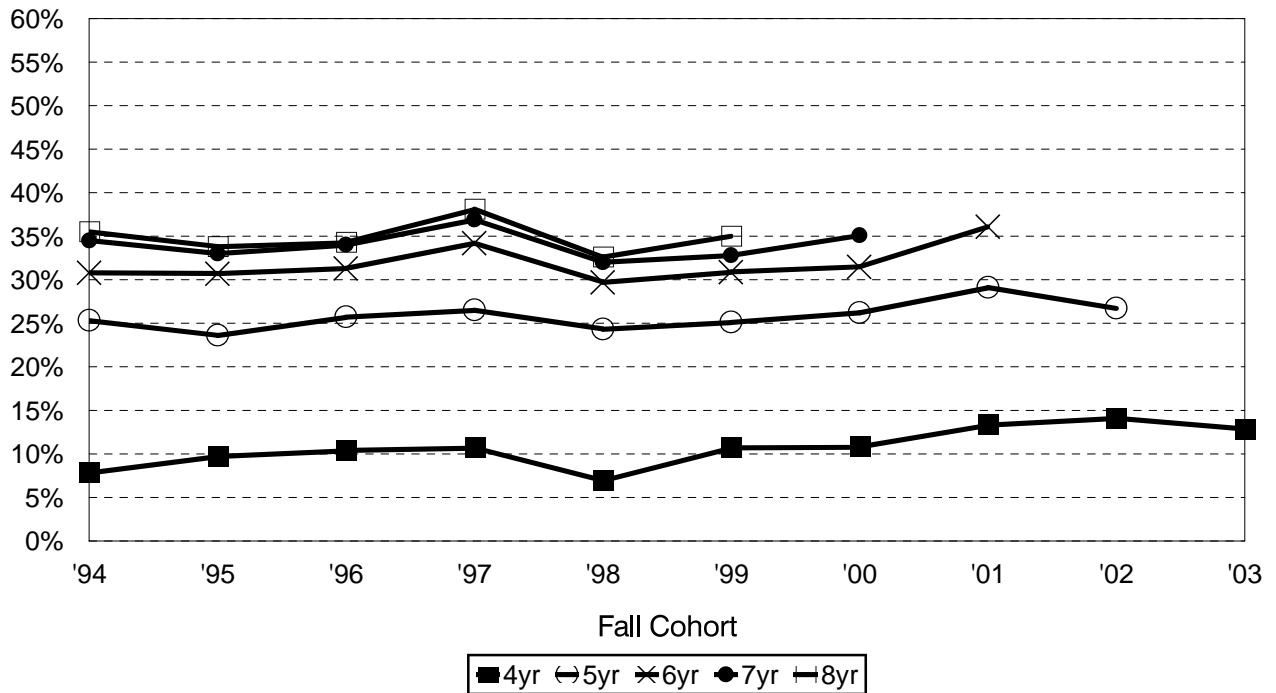

First Year Retention Rate

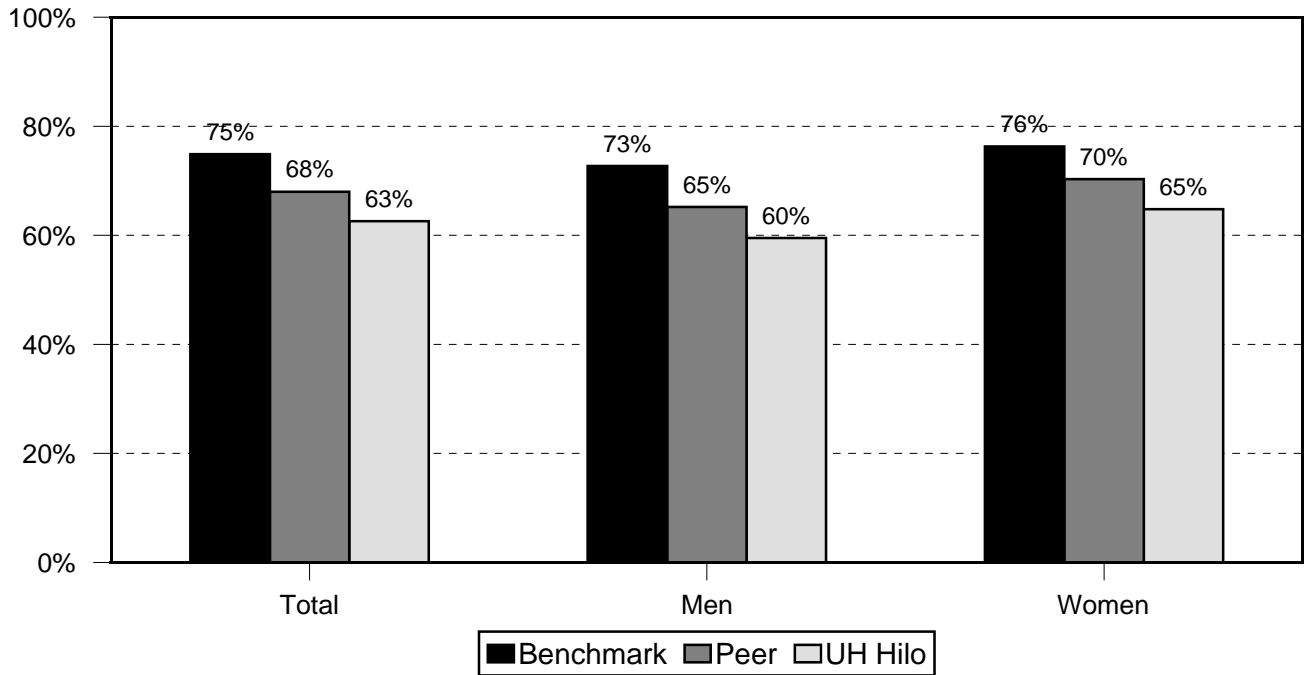
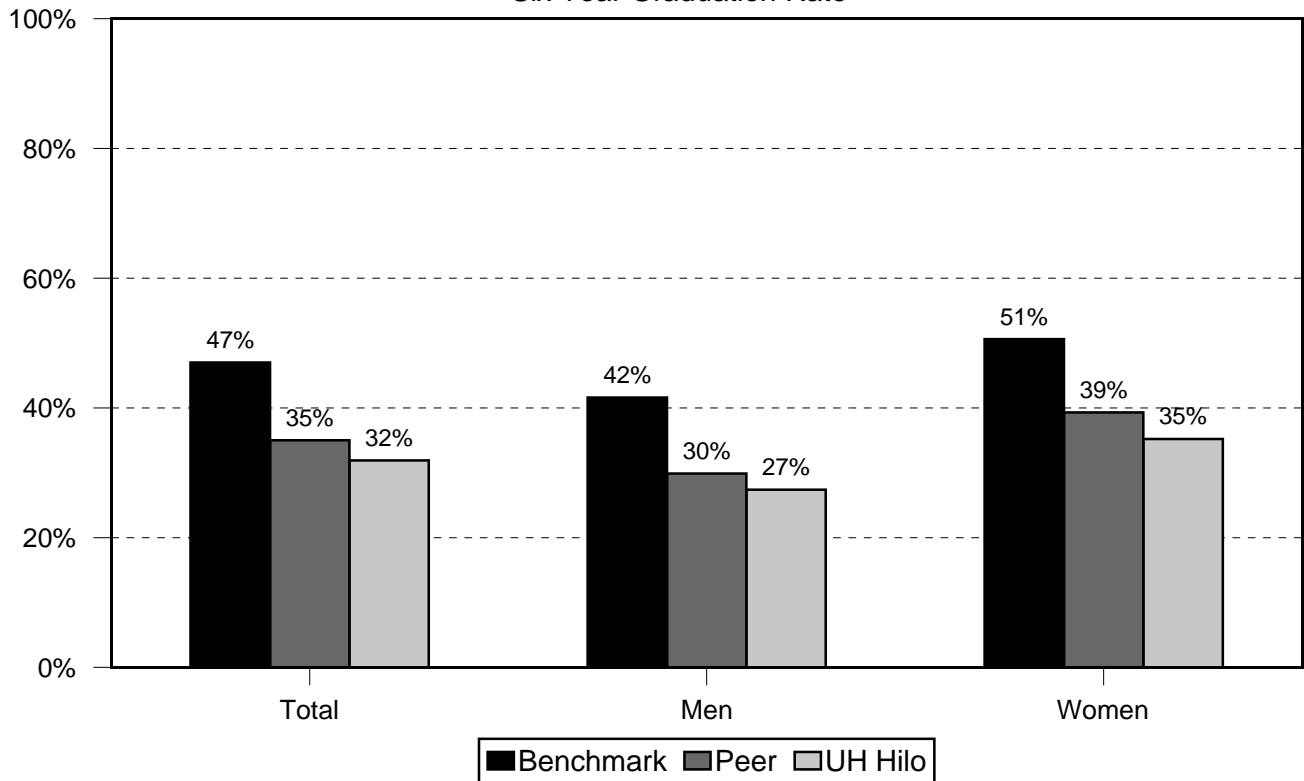
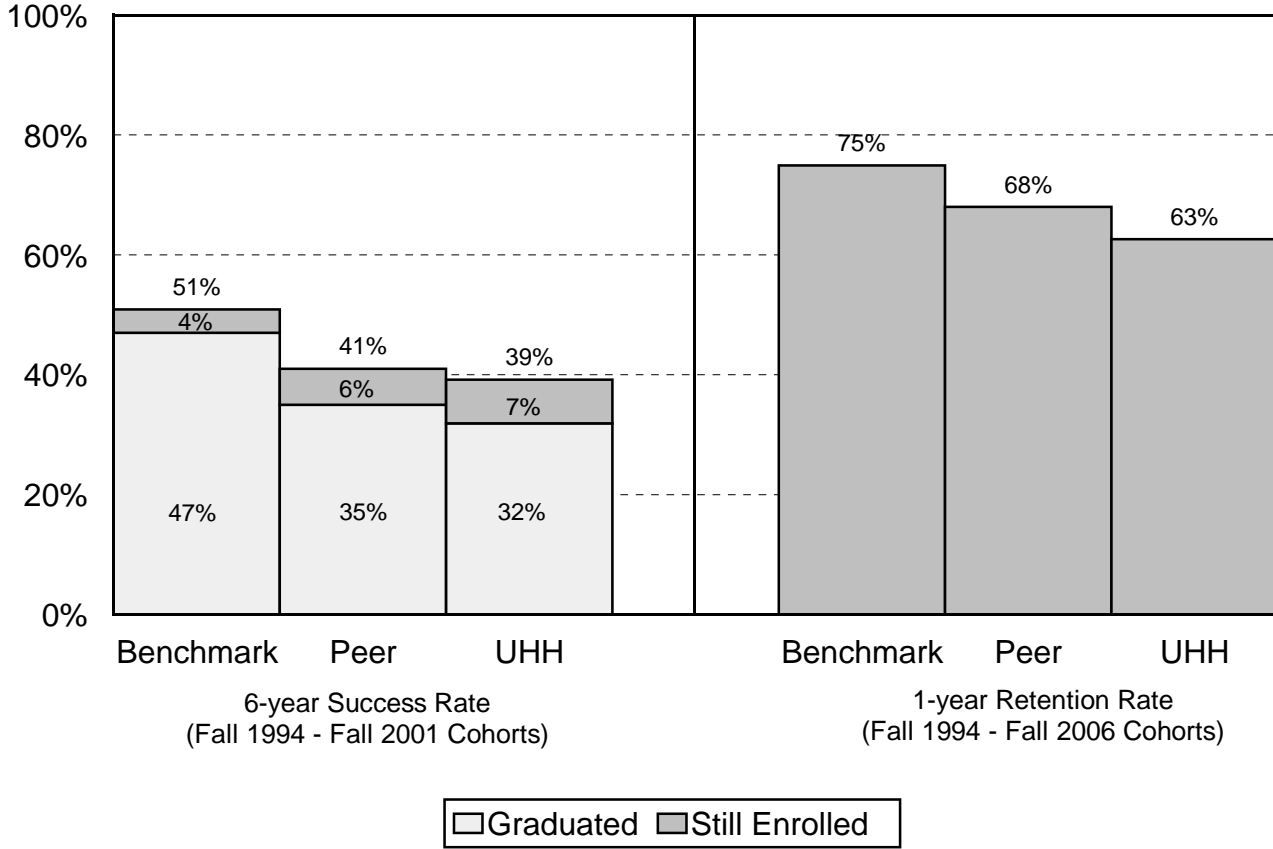

Success Rates by Ethnicity

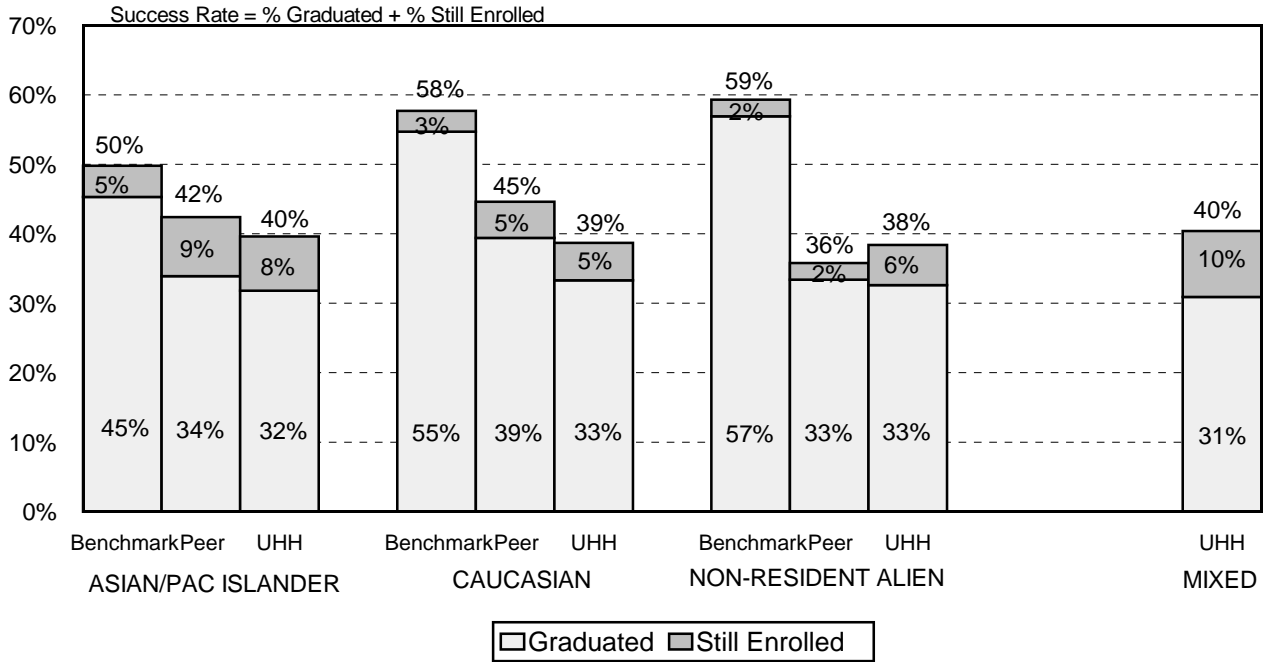
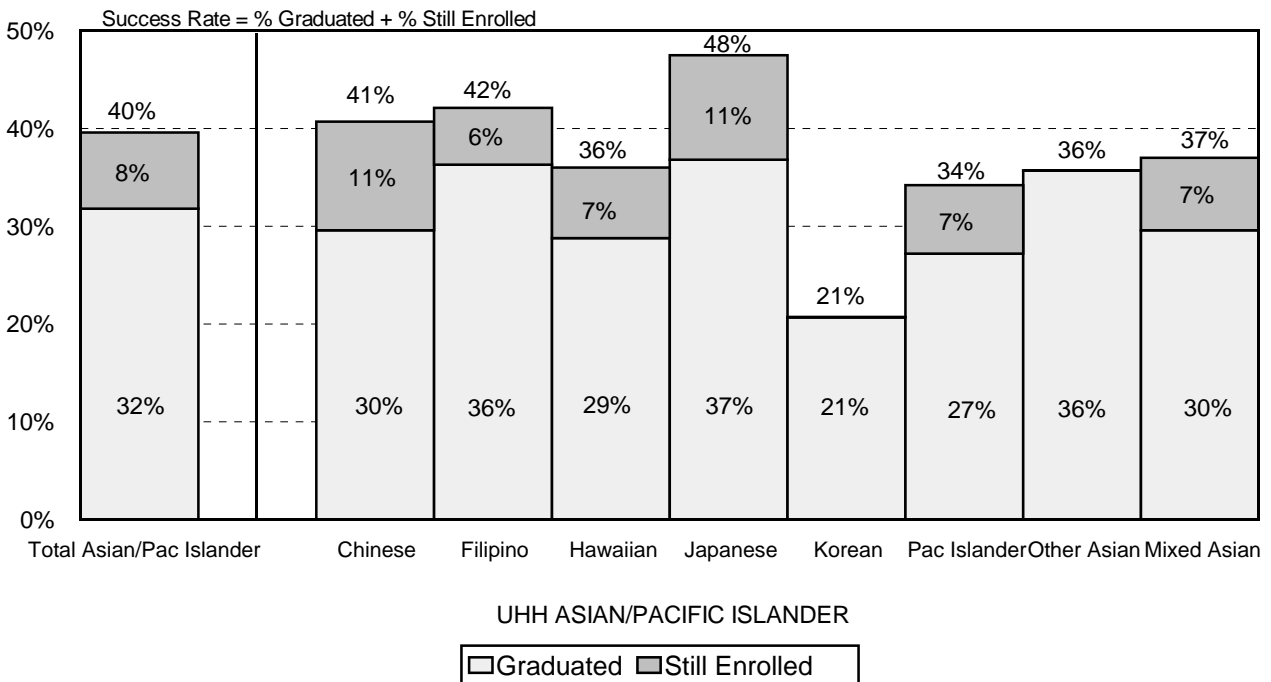


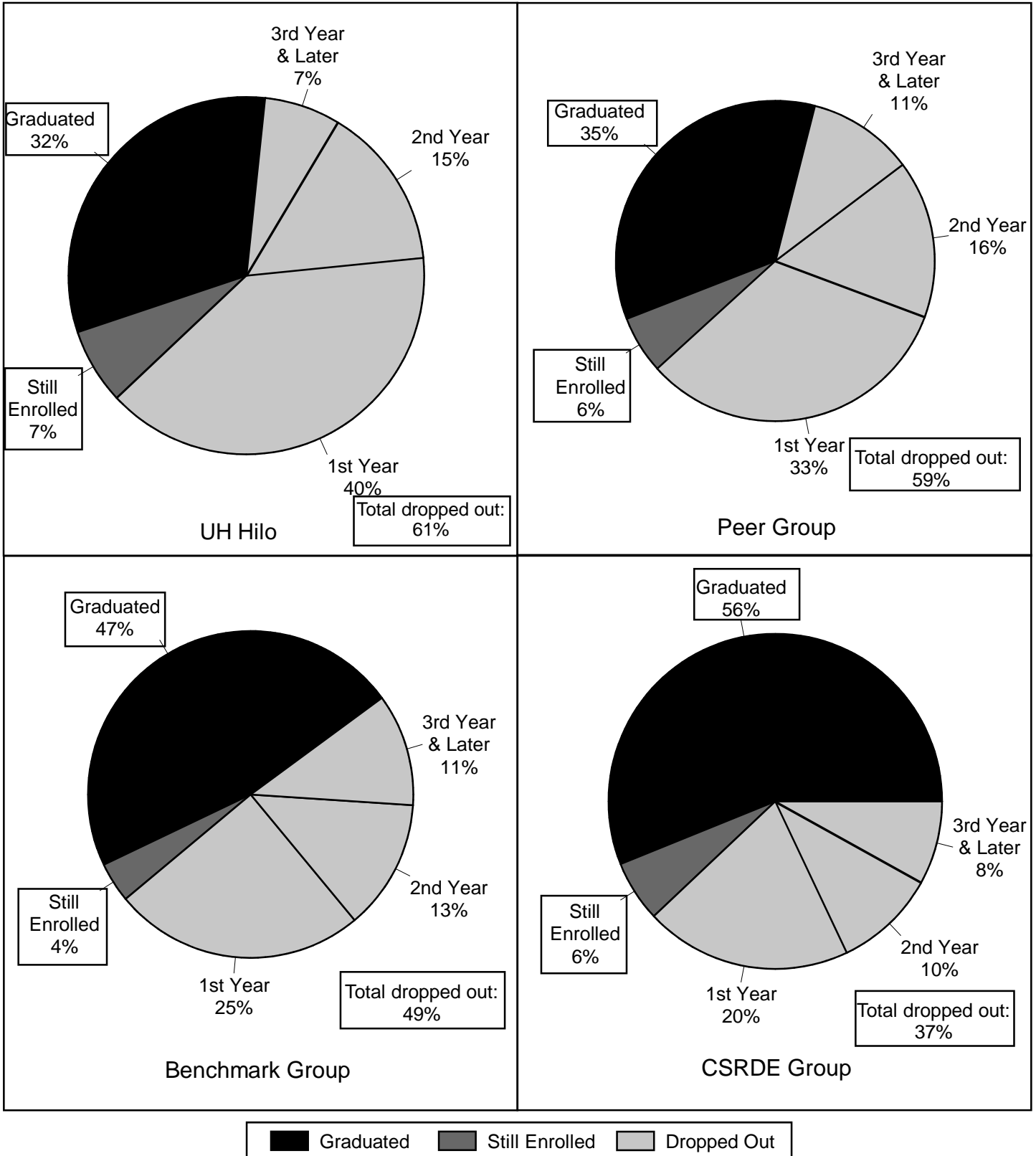
