Purpose:

The Kamehameha Schools Alumni Association - East Hawaii Region, Māmalahoe Chapter ("KSAA-EHRMC") is pleased to offer a program in which monetary scholarships will be awarded to applicants who are selected and will attend the University of Hawai'i-Hilo ("UHH") or at Hawai'i Community College ("HawCC") for the 2020 Fall semester. This scholarship program is meant to assist and encourage Kamehameha Schools (K.S.) alumni from all three Kamehameha campuses and attendees of the Kamehameha Schools Kuamahi Education Programs (Middle/High) to further their education at UHH or HawCC. Applicants will be ranked. In the event a selectee declines a scholarship award, the scholarship will then be offered to the next ranked applicant. Monies will be presented to the awardees upon submission of their acceptance to and registration for their 2020 Fall classes at the UHH or HawCC.

Amount:

A minimum of four (4) \$1000 scholarships will be offered during this scholarship season.

Application Deadline:

Your application must be postmarked no later than March 30, 2020.

How to Apply:

1. In the attached "2020 KSAA-EHRMC Scholarship Application Form," please complete and submit Part A, Part B, and the Signature of Applicant sections.
2. By the application deadline, submit the following additional documentation:
 - a. Current Kamehameha Schools seniors must submit an official copy of their most current high school transcript. K.S. graduates need to submit proof of their graduation/diploma from their respective campuses.
 - b. Current/former attendees of the Kamehameha Schools Kuamahi Educational programs are asked to submit the name and dates of the program(s) they attended.
3. K.S. graduates or former attendees of the Kamehameha Schools Kuamahi Educational programs currently attending UHH or HawCC are asked to submit an official copy of their most current transcripts.
4. K.S. graduates or former attendees of the Kamehameha Schools Kuamahi Educational programs transferring from another educational institution to UHH/HawCC for Fall 2020 must submit a copy of your official transcript(s) from your previous college(s) or university(s).

1. An essay on any of the following topics:
 - a. Describe and explain the significance of one of the major person(s) who has influenced you - in seeking the path for your higher education.
 - b. What does it mean to be a "steward"? Cite examples of your feelings and stewardship to others.
 - c. Your ability to lead or positively influence others.
2. Your vision for yourself in the next 5 years.
3. One recommendation from an instructor, counselor, or administrator from your Kamehameha Schools Campus or current educational institution that you attend.

*** Names of scholarship selectees will be announced and notification sent out by April 20, 2020. Declined scholarships will be awarded to the next highest ranked scholarship applicants.

*** Awarding of funds will be disbursed to the awardee after the scholarship committee is contacted by the awardee and a copy of his/her Fall 2020 enrollment confirmation (i.e. class schedule) at UHH or HawCC is received.
