A copy of your high school diploma.

An academic transcript that confirms you successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If you are not able to provide any of the documents listed above, please contact the Financial Aid Office as soon as possible as your eligibility for Federal student aid may be affected.
