

## 2009 – 2018 Program Review Schedule

Only degree programs will be reviewed. Departments may choose to reference their certificates and minors in the narrative portion of the self study, but separate data tables will not be provided for these unless the department and the Dean specifically requests additional data. If additional funds are required for a review of a certificate or minor, the Vice Chancellor must also approve. Please note the following timeline (which may be subject to change for new programs due to other reporting requirements). Self-studies for CCAO/BOR can substitute for formal Program Review:

In the Academic Year *prior* to the Formal Program Review:

- Spring Semester: Dean and/or Chair and the Faculty begin compiling the Program Review  
January 15: Vice-Chancellor of Academic Affairs formally notifies the Dean of the College and/or the Chair of the Department of upcoming Program Review (to include appropriation of resources for Program Review).  
March 1: IR provides comprehensive institutional data to Department Chair and faculty for review.  
\*August 31: The Dean or Department Chair submits prospective names and schedule for external review.

In the Academic Year of the scheduled Program Review:

- Fall Semester: Dean or Chair and Faculty finalizes compiling the Program Review  
External Reviewer visits and evaluates the Department or Program (Alternately, the External Reviewer visits and evaluates in early Spring, which compresses the subsequent timeline below. Programs are encouraged to schedule the External Reviewer visit for the Fall.)  
Spring Semester: External Review and the Drafting of the MOU.  
January 15: External Reviewer will have submitted findings to the College, Department, or Program as well as to the Academic Program Review Advisory Committee and the Office of the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs. The College, Department, or Program will distribute this report to their faculty for input. The Academic Program Review Advisory Committee may also provide recommendations and suggestions for further consideration by the faculty in the unit undergoing Program Review.  
March 1: The Department or Program collectively responds to the reports from the external reviewer and Academic Program Review Advisory Committee, either for inclusion in the final report or for use during discussions with the administration regarding the MOU.  
April 15: The VCAA, Dean, Chair, and faculty in the Department begin drafting an Action Plan resulting in an MOU.  
May 15: MOU is signed and the action plan starts the next 7-year cycle for improvement.

The MAT in the School of Education was approved by the Hawai'i Teacher Standards Board in 2012 and is submitting candidacy for accreditation by the TEACHER EDUCATION ACCREDITATION COUNCIL (TEAC) with first site review in 2015.

The MA in Counseling Psychology (CAS) is accredited by the MASTERS IN PSYCHOLOGY AND COUNELING ACCREDITATION COUNCIL (MPCAC)

Kahuawaiola Indigenous Teacher Education Program is accredited by the STATE APPROVED TEACHER EDUCATION (SATE) of the HAWAI'I TEACHER STANDARDS BOARD

The PharmD is accredited by the ACCREDITATION COUNCIL FOR PHARMACY EDUCATION (ACPE). The accreditation visit just occurred in Spring of 2013.
