To earn the BA in Performing Arts, students must earn a C or higher in all required Performing Arts courses.

Applied Music fees are in addition to regular tuition. For Applied Music courses and fee structure, contact the Performing Arts department chair and consult the instructor at the time of registration.

Students enrolled in MUS 135, 136, 235, 236, 335, 336, 435, 436 are required to participate in student recitals and juries, and to be co-enrolled in a Performing Arts ensemble.

No more than 12 semester hours of ensemble courses may be applied to the upper division total required for the Music Concentration.

Students enrolled in DRAM 350 who have no previous sewing experience also **must** enroll concurrently in DRAM 350L: Stage Co:
