1. Students must earn at least a 2.0 GPA in courses required for the major.
 2. MATH 121 meets the GE Quantitative Reasoning Requirement. The Quantitative Reasoning course must be passed with a "C" grade or better.
 3. All Natural Science courses must be passed with a "C" grade or better.
 4. NURS 348 and NURS 375 both must be passed with a "C" grade or better.
 5. RN to BSN students replace NURS 459-459L with NURS 361-362.
 6. Basic students who transfer into the BSN program must complete a minimum of 63 credits of UH Hilo nursing courses. These credits must include: NURS 347-347L, 350, 351, 352L, 353-353L, 355-355L, 356-356L, 357-357L, 358, 455-455L, 456-456L, 410-410L, 457-457L, 459-459L.
