RECOGNIZING ABUSIVE BEHAVIORS

1. Possessiveness: controlling your actions & limiting privacy
2. Excessive jealousy & insecurity
3. Emotional instability & volatility, explosive temper
4. Belittling
5. Isolation from family and friends
6. Physical harm, & threats of harm
